Waterman's is excited to announce our new Program's Coordinator, Kate Kirby!

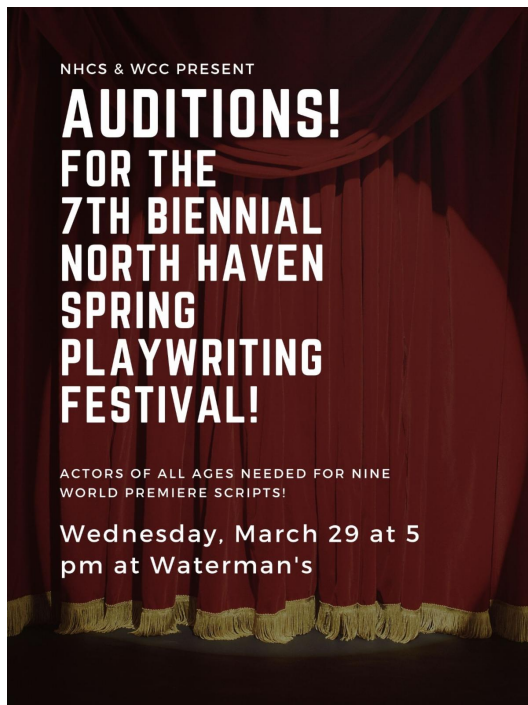

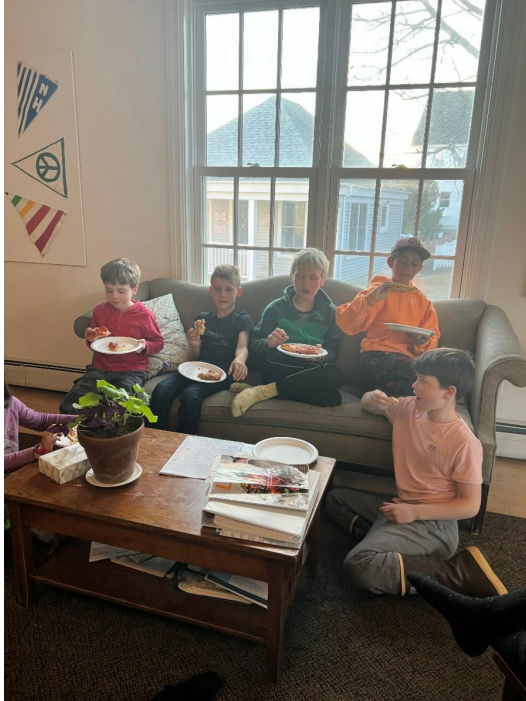
